1. Organisational Overview

DPM Digital Health Consultancy Ltd is a UK-based regulatory compliance consultancy providing clinical safety, regulatory compliance, governance, and training services to healthcare organisations and digital health manufacturers.

The organisation operates as a home-based, remote-first consultancy, with:

- Two directors working from home offices
- One employed staff member working remotely
- Six subcontractors, all home-based and working remotely

There are no dedicated office premises, warehouses, or physical operational facilities. Most services are delivered virtually, with occasional travel to client sites when required.

2. Organisational Boundary

This Carbon Reduction Plan covers:

- Core business activities of DPM Digital Health Consultancy Ltd
- Home-working arrangements for directors and employees
- Remote subcontractor working where DPM Digital Health commissions the activity
- Business travel undertaken on behalf of the organisation

Excluded:

- Personal commuting not related to DPM Digital Health work
- Emissions directly controlled by client organisations
- Supply-chain emissions beyond reasonable influence (e.g. third-party platforms)

3. Baseline Emissions Footprint

Given the organisation's size and operating model, DPM Digital Health has a very low baseline carbon footprint.

Scope 1 - Direct Emissions

- Nil
- No owned or leased vehicles
- No gas-heated commercial premises

Scope 2 - Energy Indirect Emissions

- Minimal
- Electricity usage limited to home-office working
- No dedicated office energy consumption

Scope 3 - Other Indirect Emissions

- Business travel (primarily public transport)
- Occasional overnight accommodation for training delivery
- IT equipment and digital services

A full quantified footprint is considered disproportionate at present given organisational size and impact; however, emissions sources are understood and actively minimised.

4. Current Carbon Reduction Measures

DPM Digital Health already embeds the following low-carbon practices:

Remote-First Delivery

- Majority of consultancy, training, mentoring, and governance support delivered via:

Sustainable Travel

- Public transport is the default for all site visits (rail, underground, bus)
- Taxis and private vehicles used only where unavoidable
- Flights avoided wherever practical

Digital-Only Operations

- No routine printing: documents shared electronically
- Digital marketing and communications
- Cloud-based document storage and collaboration

Resource Efficiency

- Minimal IT hardware footprint
- Equipment purchased only when required
- Devices used for their full lifecycle before replacement

5. Carbon Reduction Targets

DPM Digital Health commits to:

- Maintaining a low-carbon operating model through continued remote-first delivery
- Avoiding unnecessary travel and prioritising virtual engagement
- Reviewing carbon impacts annually as the organisation grows
- Working towards Net Zero by 2050, in line with UK Government targets

Given the organisation's size, growth will be managed in a way that does not disproportionately increase emissions, particularly through unnecessary office space or travel.

6. Planned Future Measures (2026-2030)

Over the next five years, DPM Digital Health will:

1. Formalise travel guidance
2. Supplier & Partner Consideration
3. Training & Awareness
4. Proportionate Measurement
5. Avoid Unnecessary Physical Expansion

7. Governance and Responsibility

Responsibility for carbon reduction sits with the Clinical Director of DPM Digital Health Consultancy Ltd, who oversees:

- Operational delivery models
- Travel and engagement approaches
- Supplier and partnership decisions

Carbon reduction considerations are embedded into business planning and service delivery decisions, rather than treated as a standalone activity.
